

## **FERRIS CAMPUS SHUTTLE LOOP – 9 STOPS**

A continuous shuttle bus Starting at 7:30 am in Lot 19 Monday thru Friday

1. Lot 19 (South East Corner)
2. Allied Health Building (Front)
3. West Campus Community Center
4. Sports Complex (West Doors)
5. Travis Hall (On Road by Stairs that go into Lot 4)
6. Rock Café by Brophy Hall
7. South Street (3-way Stop sign by Recreation Center)
8. North Campus Drive (3-way stop North of University Center)
9. Front of the Arts and Science Building (by Stop Sign).

Bus will only stay at any stop long enough to let passengers on or off. It will not sit and wait at any stop, passengers must be out and ready to board. If no one is out at the stop and no one on the bus is getting off at that stop the bus will keep moving.

**DART may have to deviate off of the route, up to a 1/4 mile, at any given time, but would only deviate if needed. Call the DART office at least 2 hours in advance to arrange for deviation in which you will be charged our regular fare of \$2.00 for adults and \$1.00 for Children, Senior and Disabled riders.**

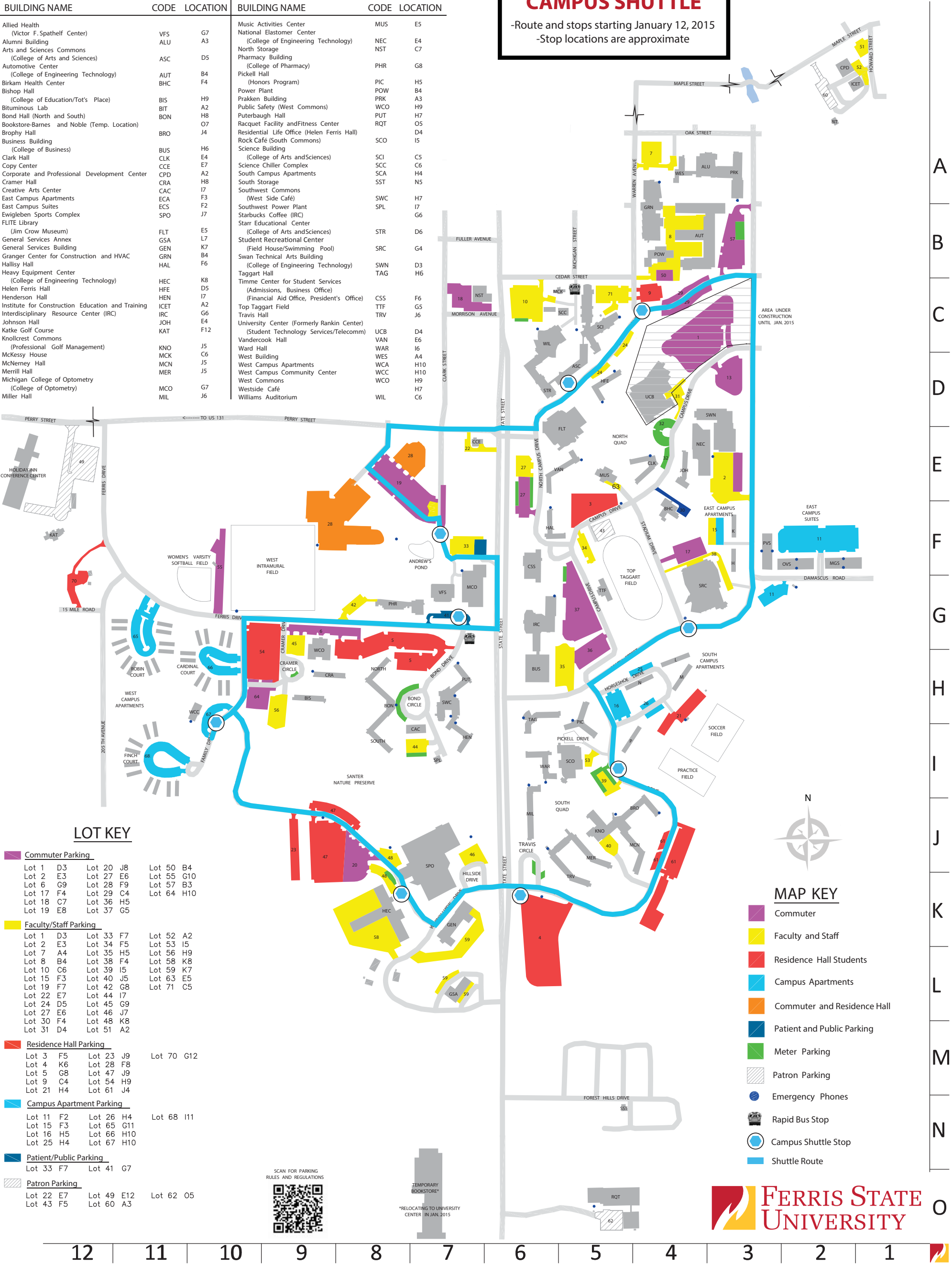
